1- TPSN attempting to contact to discuss pilot (on run/not responding/working with DCFS)

20 – became ineligible

- 6- declined HFI outreach

- 1-child removed before outreach
- 8-family moved/outside of pilot area
- 2-aged out before communication
- 3-not parenting

CURRENT TREND:

There has been a higher rate of case transfer's over the last few months:

- 2- youth have already moved and opened successfully at new agency
- 2 - HFI site is working on outreach to open family but has been working with last agency (with consent)
- 1- youth moving soon but not sure about wanting to transfer to new site
- 1- youth pilot team is looking for HFI agency placement (youth is highly transient and not currently parenting)
